Taxis can be booked via phone or apps, and Uber operates in Bahrain. Additionally, passengers can use the Bahrain Taxi app or call +973 1666 1666 to book a ride.*

*Bahrain has a well-connected public bus network, with buses running every 10 to 20 minutes on main routes. Passengers can pay with cash or use a GO Card, which costs 500 fils (about USD 1.32) and is available at the airport and bus terminals. Seven-day and 28-day passes are also offered. 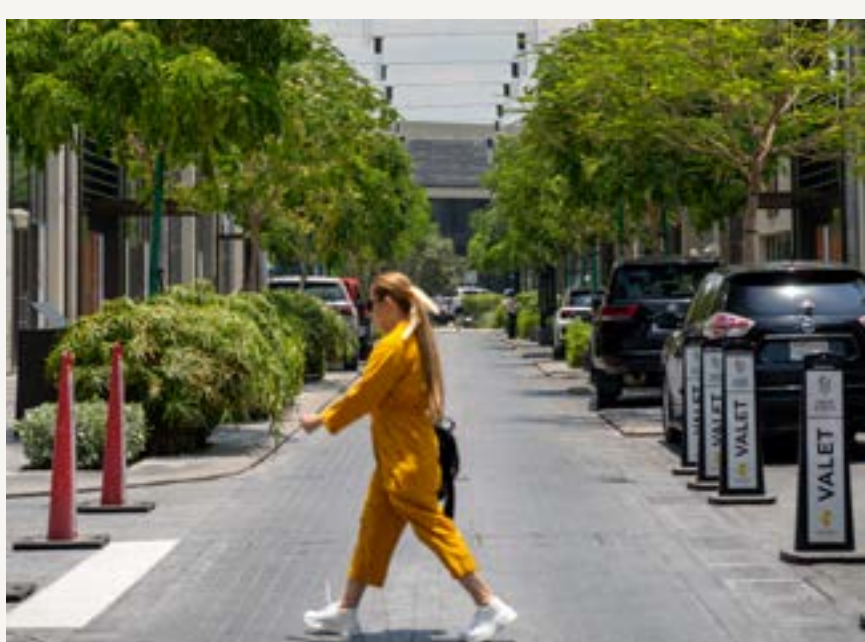


## Car Rental

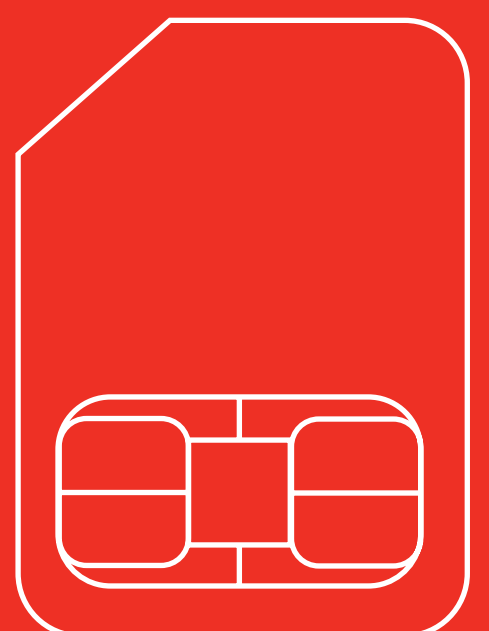
## Free Wi-Fi
